



How to Submit Responses to Vote411

You will submit all your materials through an online web-form. We hope you find this easy to use. If not, we're here to help!

- Before you get started, you might want to take a look at the online form. You can come back to it at anytime. Click the link in your invitation email to view the form.
- If your security settings don't allow you to use the link, copy-and-paste the following address into your browser to view the form: <http://lwv.thevoterguide.org/candidate/login.do>. You will be asked to enter the security code in your email invitation.
- Now might be a good time to check out our FAQs. They contain detailed instructions and answers to other questions.
- Obtain a 2" x 3" photo (i.e., U.S. Passport size) in jpeg, jpg or png format, go to the form, upload your photo, and enter your responses to the questions listed.
- Although you can type directly into the web-form, we suggest you type your responses into a document you save on your computer and then cut-and-paste them into the online form. This will give you a back-up copy in case you encounter "computer gremlins" in the middle of posting your materials.
- Typing your answers with a word processor program will let you make sure your answers do not exceed the size restrictions for a response before you post them. The web-form will not allow your answer to exceed 1,000 characters including spaces and punctuation.
- Finally, a word about your picture: it is definitely to your advantage to upload one. A photo tends to capture the voter's attention making it more likely they will read your profile.

- When you complete your entry, click on the PREVIEW button in the blue box at the bottom of the page to see what you posted. After reviewing your materials, you have the choice of clicking EDIT or SUBMIT. **Make sure you click the blue SUBMIT button** before you exit the site or nothing will be saved.
- If your submission was accepted, you will receive a Receipt of Responses email within a few minutes. If you don't receive this or have any questions, contact us by return email.
